Participants

All participants must be a minimum of associate members of the CWHBA. The age range will be 13-25 as of January 1st, 2017. Any participants wishing to qualify for either the junior or senior Young Breeders team Representing the CWHBA at the IYB World Championships in July 2017 must be ages 16-25 as of January 1st, 2016. Younger participants may compete, but will not be eligible for inclusion on the international team. Where numbers are present the teams will be split into provincial junior and senior groups. **Cost of attending is \$25, meals are excluded.**

Clothing

Participants are required to have green tops and black pants for the competition showmanship portion. Gloves and safety approved helmets are recommended. Appropriate footwear and clothing for inclement weather is recommended.
